ANNUAL REPORT 2016-17

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell helped students to prepare for suitable careers and created a lot of job opportunities for the students. The career guidance and placement cell organize various workshops and orientation programs to train the students to realize their goals for further studies and setting their careers. The Cell conducts coaching classes to equip them for competitive exams. It also ensures to give necessary and relevant information and technical assistance for placements. The Career Guidance and Placement Cell concentrate its activities on the following during this academic year:

Eminence 2017 (Management Studies)

The Department of Management studies organized "Eminence" an intra-collegiate career guidance program on how to prepare for CA/CS/ICWA/CMA exams on 31-01-2017. The program was attended by 90 students from different batches of BBA who were interested to prepare for the above exams. The objectives of the program were to mold students into career aspirants, to understand their interest, aptitude, and potential, to understand the world of the job market, to develop career alternatives based on their potential, and assist career aspirants in career preparation and development. Mr. Arun Augustine, a Company Secretary by profession was the resource person. He covered various topics like eligibility criteria for these courses, syllabi, job opportunities available for the qualified candidates, the difference between these different courses, etc.

Competitive Exams And Higher Education (Commerce)

The department of commerce conducts various competitive exams preparations classes for the department students each year. PG Entrance Exam Coaching (Psychology)




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The department of Psychology has organized PG entrance exam coaching for the students who are willing to pursue their higher studies after graduation. The session was handled by faculty from the Psychology department. The students were guided in a different way. Different forms of simple coaching methods were used. Mind mapping and short note preparation strategies were discussed well for the students. Multiple-choice questions were solved and given to the students to get in touch with different forms of questions. All basic reference books and questions available were provided. Students were asked to create their questions and answers to enhance their learning.
