


2. PROUDA-OFFICIAL INAUGURATION OF WDC AND KSWDC RECOGNITION







A total of 107 students participated in this webinar.










5. AUGUST 15-INDEPENDENCE DAY-FINDING HER VOICE

6. STHREEDANA VIRUDHA BODHAVALKARANA WEBINAR



7. ONAM CELEBRATION 2K21



9. AUGUST-28 A DEBATE ON GENDER AS A SOCIAL CONSTRUCT



The objective of this program was to make the students aware about the women rights and also making them take a step in breaking the stereotypes that is prevalent in the society.







11. TEACHERS DAY CELEBRATION-SEPTEMBER 5


In connection with Teachers Day Celebration, WDC of MCAS conducted two competitions online during these covid-19 situation, one for the teachers and the other for the students.






The resource person was Mr. Libin Thathapilly, Gender Activist and Journalist. Around 50 students attended the webinar.



The students were given an overall idea regarding the various investment and saving avenues. They were informed about the merits of saving a part of their income at a very early stage of their life.














15. SEPTEMBER 29 A WEBINAR ON GENDER BASED VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND RESPONSE



A total of 133 students participated in the webinar and interacted well with the resource person.












The programme was highly appreciated by the students and they requested to offer follow-up sessions so as to reinforce the lessons learned.
















The workshop focused on teaching basics of art, painting, mixing colors and using canvas. All the students drew a canvas each and it was later displayed in College notice board.













Students prepared articles, posters, arts and short poems to create awareness among the students of the college.











25. DECEMBER 15 INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY: REBUILDING BETTER, FAIRER AND GREENER

80 students participated in this class and they interacted with the resource person regarding the various adolescent problems they are facing ang how to solve them.


















27. DECEMBER 22 A SEMINAR ON LAWS FOR THE PROTECTION AND RIGHT OF WOMEN AND CHILDREN


28. JANUARY 6 FITNESS FIX: A SEMINAR ON WELLNESS AND FITNESS






37. FEBRUARY 17 REIZEN THROUGH CAREER: A TALK ON TRAVEL AND TOURISM PATHWAY




39. FEBRUARY 24 REVOLUTION 2K22: PEDDLE YOUR WAY AHEAD
